All our sites are working at normal capacity and our manufacturing activities, logistics and support are regularly proceeding to guarantee the supply of research products and services to our clients, through our net of subsidiaries and distributors.**

During this challenging time, in fact, Tecniplast's focus remains on creating the best possible conditions to continue supporting our customers and maintaining the high service level you expect from us, while ensuring the health and safety of all those who interact with our facilities, of our employees and of the local communities in which we operate.
